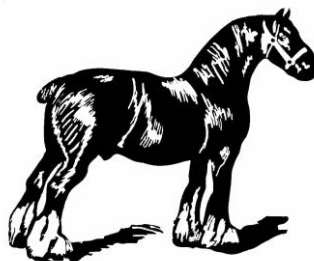

PEPPERMINT MERINGUE

- Lightly grease tin foil and lay on baking tray.
- 2 whites of eggs. 4 oz castor sugar.
- Place the egg whites in a bowl & whisk on maximum speed until stiff & dry. Add half the sugar and whisk well again until stiff. Then fold in the remaining sugar carefully.
- Place individual meringues onto the foil.
- Place in the oven at 100°C and bake until meringues are firm & dry. 2 – 3 hours.
- Filling - double cream. Box of After Eight mints or similar.
- Whip the cream. Chop up the mints & mix with the cream & use to sandwich the two halves of meringue together.

PINEAPPLE UPSIDE-DOWN CAKE

8oz /226g can pineapple slices in syrup

Cherries

4oz /125g caster sugar

6oz/175g self-raising flour

4oz/125g butter

2-3tbsp milk

2 eggs.beaten

Few drops vanilla essence

- Preheat oven180c
- Drain pineapple, reserve syrup & place in a greased tin or dish. Add cherries.
- Cream butter and sugar. Beat in eggs & vanilla.
- Fold in flour & little milk.
- Spoon mixture over fruit & bake for 30-40 minutes, until just firm.
- Turn out onto plate. Gentle heat the syrup & pour over the cake.
